

Once a month since 2007, a group of men here at New Hope met on a Saturday morning for breakfast at 7:30, until the COVID-19 March 2020 locked-down. This group took turns serving breakfast, nurtured friendships through conversations on Spiritual Growth, current state of the world as well as the needs of the Church, They supported New Hope with various projects such as All-Church Baseball and Golf Outings in the Summer, Thanksgiving Dinner in the Fall, Mother's Day Dinner in the Spring, Tests/Trivias on various topics and made financial donations on various projects.

After four years of not coming together, seventeen men were gathered back as Men's Breakfast Club on March 4, 2023 with a new time of 8:30 a.m. and some of the same practices: taking turns serving breakfast; nurturing Christian Friendships through conversations (Yes, we are being intentional on encouraging men from all the three Services to come!); taking the men on summer activities; supporting Church projects; and exploring other practices of Spiritual Formation and Growth.

Right now, those who have attended have agreed to meet from September through June and will have a break during the months of July and August. We are hoping to have a Coordinator/Leader when we reconvene in September.

We have quite a few of our Men who have lost their spouses and Men moving to new places with limited physical mobilities from March 2019 through March 2023 and this Men's Breakfast Club at 8:30 a.m. on the first Saturday of each month is always going to be a great time to have a group and or a place to connect with.

We appreciate all of you who have made monthly pledges to this project until fully paid. All of your donations, regardless the amount, was and is, greatly appreciated!


