2020 Fall Harvest Music Jamboree and Auction

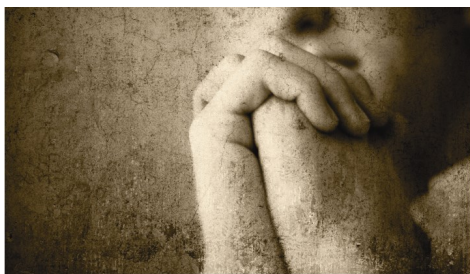

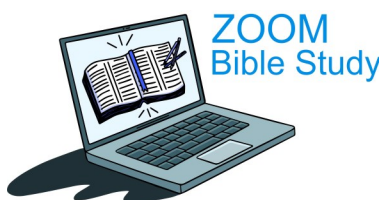
Bidwell-Riverside Center

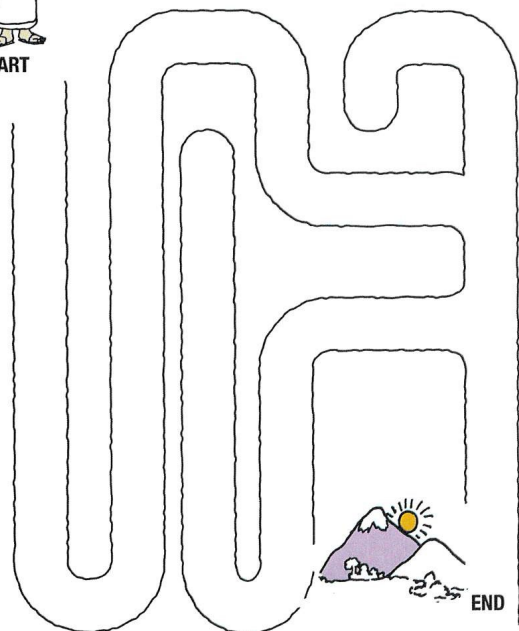

CONTINUING SUPPORT OF OUR PARTNERSHIP AGENCIES: Each month checks are issued from the Mission Fund to the following: Missionary, Dr. Emmanuel Mefor, Women at the Well, Bidwell Riverside, Johnston Partnership, Urbandale Food Pantry, and DMARC.

LITTLE FREE PANTRY: Meredith Drive Reformed Church at 5128 Meredith Drive has installed a “Little Free Pantry” in their parking lot on the north side of Meredith Drive across from the church. It is being used by the neighborhood. Donations of food are welcome plus there is a basket for fresh produce donations under the pantry.



Hand of Luke, October 14th: This is our monthly ministry of a meal for the Central Iowa Shelter and Services.


Since the pandemic started, we have been able to continue our Hand of Luke program thanks to the congregation’s monetary donations. We have used these donations to purchase the food needed to provide a meal. We will continue to do this for the foreseeable future instead of asking the congregation to purchase and drop off food items at the church as in the past. You can either include your donation in the Sunday offering with it designated for HOL or go to the church’s website and do an online donation. Click on Gifts and then fill in the amount on the Hand of Luke line.

We have been asking for volunteers to help prepare the meal and volunteers to deliver it to the Central Iowa Shelter. They are not allowing outside volunteers to serve the meal at this time. For the meal prep, our goal is to only have two people at the church at a given time. These people are usually in the same household or family unit. If you would be willing to help with this, please let Jolene Harlow know and we will contact you when needed.

Finally, we are looking for a couple people who would like to join Jolene Harlow and Patrice Webber as part of the HOL Program Coordinator team. One of the effects of the pandemic season is the burden of so many families to put food on the table. The good news is that we always have something to share so that nobody is hungry. Never underestimate the power of a hand-full of uncooked rice, a cup of uncooked beans, a ladle of maize, a cup of cassava fufu and a can of soup!

When all these are gathered into a “Grain Bin”, New Hope will certainly bring smile and hope to our neighbors. Thanks to Paulette and

Larry Wood for purchasing the “Grain Bin” ready to receive your donations.

Staying healthy requires healthy food. To our Asian, African, Latinx and immigrant neighbors, healthy food includes: rice, maize, cassava flour, and beans. Making these foods available to them will help them with their other basic needs of living, especially when there are school-aged children in the family.

The inspiration of this “Grain Bin” was Pastor Lilian’s story: A poor family of six in the village cooked three cups of raw rice every day. Before the mother/wife adds water into the pot, she sets aside a hand-scoop of the rice into a container. At the end of each month, the family offers to their Church the set aside rice.

When the Grain Bin is full, the donations will be given to Johnston Partnership, Bidwell Riverside and the Urbandale Food Pantry, on a rotation schedule.

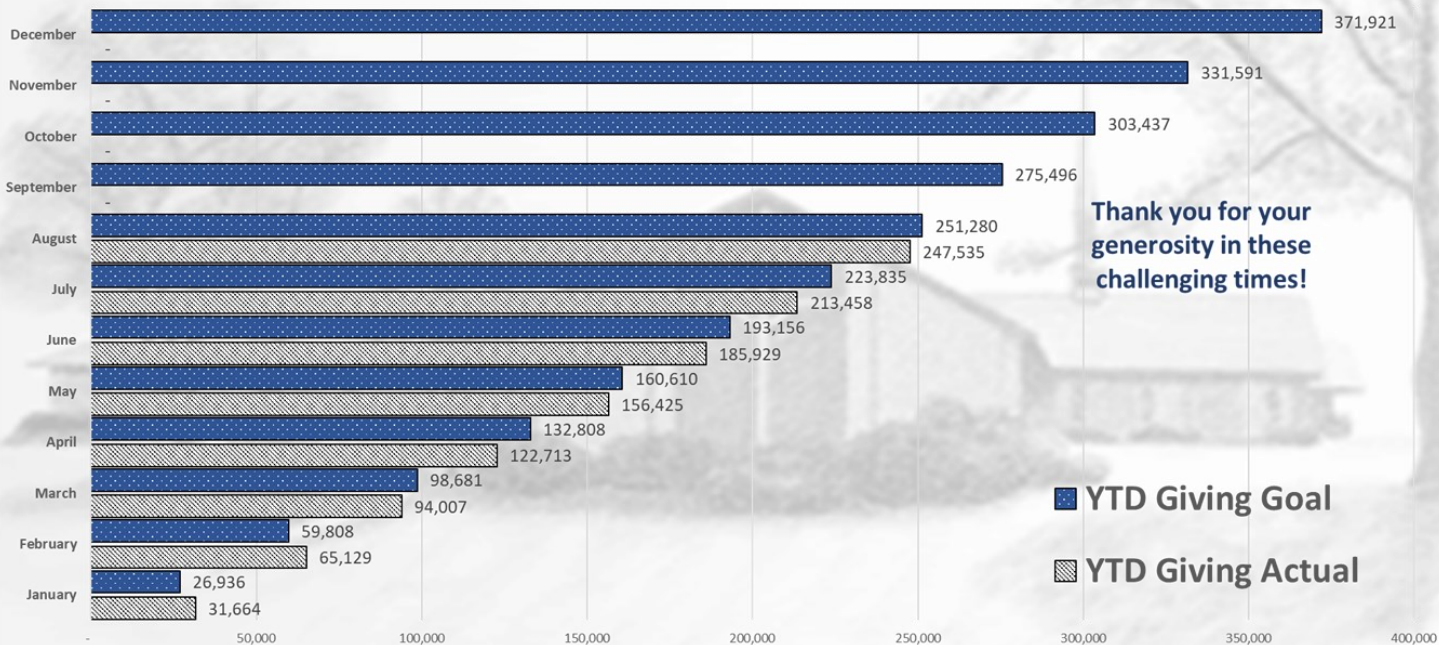
