
When we all work together we can achieve great things. Every hour, every dollar is a gift to God. Thank you for your gifts of Time, Talent and Treasure.


It is for a New Hope Bible Study!

Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT) Survey

Leaders of the CAT Implementation Task Force have begun gathering information and ideas from various church groups/committees regarding each of the top five(5) priorities. On July 21st, members of the Worship Cluster (Christian Education, Missions, Bridges and Hand of Luke) participated in a facilitated conversation to share their ideas and suggestions on Priority 1- Make necessary changes to attract families with children and youth to our church, and Priority 2-Develop and implement a comprehensive strategy to reach new people and incorporate them into the life of the church.

On August 11th, church groups/committees interested in Priority 3-Provide new opportunities for Christian education and spiritual formation at every age and stage of life, Priority 4-Create more opportunities for people to form meaningful relationships, and Priority 5, Work to renew and revitalize the community around the church by building coalitions and partner with other teams participating in a similar session.

Task force members will then summarize and analyze this information as well as other related material from the CAT Survey and develop preliminary recommendations which will be shared with Administrative Council in late September. Stay tuned for more information and ways that you can participate in this important church initiative.

New Hope's Kick off is on Sept. 12th, we would like to do a meet and greet with our teachers and kids who are looking at coming to Sunday School.



The Iowa Conference of the United Methodist Church “Ingathering” will be held November 6, 2021. The purpose of Mission Ingathering is to show the Love of Christ to the world’s people by ministering to their needs. This year our Missions Committee will participate by contributing Birthing Kits.

Birthing Kit includes:

1 bar soap, 3 to 4 oz

2 receiving blankets. 28”x28” to 32”x32”. No crib, fleece or thermal blankets

1 pair gloves - surgical or thin rubber gloves

1 one-gallon resealable plastic bag

1 square yard clear plastic sheeting—no trash bags or shower curtains *This has already been donated*

3 pieces cotton string—each 12” long. *This has already been donated*

1 Razor Blade—single edge— cover in paper or cardboard to prevent injury *This has already been donated*

For the month of AUGUST, we will continue to collect Receiving Blankets 28” x 28” to 32” x 32” - no crib, fleece or thermal blankets. Please place in the container on the Missions table in the Fellowship Hall.

Monthly checks continue to be sent to: Bidwell Riverside, Women at the Well, African Immigrant and Refugee Transition Services (AIRTS), missionary Dr. Emmanuel Mefor, Des Moines Area Religious Council (DMARC), Johnston Partnership and Urbandale Food Pantry.

We will no longer collect Campbell Soup labels or General Mills box tops as these program have been discontinued or altered.

We are also no longer collecting empty medicine bottles.

Bidwell Riverside Center is committed to a vision of a future where no one lives in poverty and every person has the opportunity for a positive future. Established in 1893 by a group of Methodist women dedicated to helping disadvantaged families, Bidwell has evolved into a secular organization seeking to build hope for a better future by providing support through two primary programs: Food and Clothing Pantry and Child Development Center.

Members of New Hope UMC have volunteered at the Food and Clothing Pantry for several years and will have opportunities to do so again later this year. Watch the LINK for updates.




One of the highlights of our Stewardship and Finance Committee’s work during the quarter was the Mission Fair held on June 13th in our campus. Fourteen Ministry and Mission Partners participated with their displays of what they have been doing during the last six months. Many of these partners are organizations outside of New Hope that are responding to families in poverty, hunger, homelessness, and immigrants. We support these partners with monthly financial commitment, with volunteers and great gifts of food and other needed things. When gifts are gathered, basic human needs are satisfied!

New Hope UMC’s Board of Trustees have taken yet another project to care for our campus this year. With your support and prayers, The East Entrance Addition was completed at the end of June. This included the replacements of rotting posts by the Courtyard Garden and the completion of the stonework on the north and west sides of the building. To this date, we have raised \$64,000 towards the \$130,000 estimated cost of the project. Please know that your leaders appreciate every dollar and prayer you have invested for this project. Now that the project has been completed, gifts given today over and above your pledged amount will help reduce our building loan with the Iowa United Methodist Foundation. Thanks be to God for this holy campus and for the holy work that we all do for the glory of God!
