



#### YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF OTHERS

Personal Dignity Kits are one of the items most requested for disaster victims. These kits are given to the United Methodist Ingathering team for shipment overseas as well as in the United States – like victims of the tornado that hit Greenfield, Iowa. You can help with this project by picking up a one-gallon plastic bag at the Welcome Center which will contain the following list of items needed for the kit:



1 Hand towel – no kitchen towels

1 Shampoo – 12-19 oz

1 Washcloth – no dishcloths

1 Deodorant – 2-3 oz (stick, roll on or pump)

1 Adult toothbrush – no multipacks

1 Lotion - 8-10 oz (no pumps)

1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz

Place all items in the resealable plastic bag and place in the tub at the Welcome Center during the month of June.

The Mission Team hopes to collect several kits to help with the need not only in the United States but worldwide.



Free Little Food Pantry ~ May 2022, the New Hope congregation began to supply the Free Little Food Pantry off Meredith Drive with 20 food items every Monday. It is two years later and the New Hope congregation has done an amazing job of supporting this mission and have increased the number of food items to 50 every Monday. THANK YOU! 
**Ukulele Club** ~ Our New Hope Ukulele Club has decided to take a *summer break for June, July & August.*


